The custodian at all times shall keep custodial property separate and distinct from all other property in a manner sufficient to identify it clearly as custodial property of the minor. The custodian shall keep records of all transactions with respect to custodial property, including information necessary for the preparation of the minor's tax returns. The custodian may deliver or pay to the minor or expend for the minor's benefit as much of the custodial property as the custodian considers advisable for the use and benefit of the minor.
